- Summer Tournaments:

- ✓ One Club paid tournament (team to choose one)

- ✓ Mt. Hood Challenge August 19th - 21st

- ✓ Chinook Cup August 12th – 14th

- ✓ Other tournaments are at teams expense (limit of 2 additional)

- ✓ Cost:

- ✓ U8 - \$150 for fall season– no tournament

- ✓ U9 – U10 - \$275 for fall season

- ✓ Spring season cost: TBD based on which league club enters

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Player Development Program (PDP)

Details:

- Prepare U8, U9 & U10 kids for competitive soccer

- Continue to develop individual soccer skills (ball skills, small-sided games, fitness training, foot speed, leg strength)

- Training schedule – Two practices a week (45 min each session with staff coach then 45 minute team breakout with team coach (90 min total)

- Form Teams for outdoor leagues in May

 - Player evaluation for teams through Spring Academy in April

 - Practices start in June

 - Summer tournaments
